Curriculum

At Bluecoat Beechdale, we have re-designed our curriculum to meet the demands of the more challenging national GCSE examinations. We are at the forefront of national curriculum changes, with specialist teachers leading the way both locally and nationally. We ensure that students are fully prepared by focusing our teaching on deepening students' knowledge and understanding of the subjects they study. Through this, students are encouraged to take an active part in lessons through innovative teaching approaches.

Promoting high levels of literacy is central to our academy's ethos. We believe that if students are competent readers, they are able to think and speak well, which in turn, improves their writing. We recognise that these are vital skills that not only prepare them for their examinations, but for life beyond the academy.

Students at Bluecoat Beechdale Academy have the opportunity to study a broad and balanced curriculum, offering a diverse range of academic and vocational subjects. Subjects include: English, maths, science, humanities and languages, hairdressing, technology, computing, arts, business and finance. Students receive extensive advice and guidance on their course choices to ensure that the curriculum is tailored to their needs and maximises their opportunity for success. Furthermore, our team of academic coaches support students throughout their studies, which help them to achieve the highest possible grades through individualised study programmes.

Pastoral Care

Pastoral care at Bluecoat Beechdale Academy is central to all that we do and supports our ethos of 'Belong, Believe, Achieve'. It places 'belonging' as the key principle which underpins our work with all students and their families.

In order to make the transition from primary school to Bluecoat Beechdale Academy as smooth as possible, our transition team works closely with our feeder primaries, with our Head of Transition also leading both Year 7 and Year 8 to ensure that strong relationships are built between staff and students.

Furthermore, all of our Year Leaders are free from timetabled teaching commitments, enabling their fundamental role to support students pastorally. This ensures that all children are happy and purposeful in their studies. Our Year Leaders run our form teams and together they ensure that the high standards we have established are maintained.

We have unequivocal high standards at Bluecoat Beechdale Academy; we expect all students to have excellent behaviour, attendance and attitudes to their learning and support them on their way to achieving this. Similarly, our uniform standards are extremely high. We celebrate success through our rewards assemblies, linked to students' attitudes to learning, alongside house rewards which celebrate teamwork and belonging. Our reward trips are always well attended.

Our students and staff are proud to belong to Bluecoat Beechdale Academy, and learn together in an atmosphere of mutual respect and high aspirations.













Enrichment

Our extensive enrichment programme at Bluecoat Beechdale Academy promotes the spiritual, moral, cultural, mental and physical development of students; they help to prepare them for the opportunities, responsibilities and experiences of later life. We are proud that every single student in the academy accesses the programme, which caters for a wide range of interests.

Within the curriculum areas, students are encouraged to engage with programmes run by our local world-class universities. The students have the opportunity to compete in national competitions such as "Debate Mate" and the UKMT maths challenge, as well as join in the many STEM activities and curriculum-based visits to places of interest.

The academy organises very popular residential experiences for our students every year, including a Year 7 trip to France, a visit to the battlefields in Belgium, team building camps, and a very successful revision weekend for Year 11 students preparing for their GCSEs.

The academy has introduced a house system to encourage team building and healthy competition. We have four houses named after local people who have made positive contributions to our local area. The houses are Adlington, Sillitoe, Samuels and Lovelace. Throughout the year, we hold a wide range of events so that each and every student can use their unique blend of skills, talents and team spirit to earn points towards the overall score for their house.

The academy Sports Day is a whole school event that takes place at Harvey Hadden Sports Village, where students are able to cheer on members of their House. We also participate in the Archway Learning Trust Sports Day, where our students can compete against their peers within the Academy Trust.

We also encourage our students to work closely within the local community, participating in Community Action Projects and to raise money for local charities. We were thrilled to receive the Lord Lieutenants Award for promoting voluntary service in the community this year.
